# TREE DESCRIPTIONS



## EVERGREENS

*All varieties provide nesting habitat, food, and cover for a large variety of wildlife.*

### Techny Arborvitae:

Dwarf cultivar of American Arborvitae. Fast growing dark green evergreen. Can be used as a large shrub. Very winter hardy. Sun or light shade. Tolerates wetter conditions than other evergreens. Grows 12-25'T x 6-12'W

### American Arborvitae:

Fast growing evergreen. Lighter green color and grows larger than the Techny cultivar. Very winter hardy. Sun or light shade. Tolerates wetter conditions than other evergreens. Grows 20-40'T x 10-20'W

### Eastern Red Cedar:

Green evergreen with a touch of red. Drought tolerant. Full sun. Adapted to wide variety of soils, but prefers moisture. Grows 30-45'T x 15-30'W

### White Pine:

Cold hardy evergreen. Fastest growing and most well adapted pine for our area. Very tall and long lived. Adapted to most soils but prefers medium or well drained. Grows >100'T x 20-40'W

### Black Hills Spruce:

Medium growing evergreen. Easy to grow. Long lived, tolerant to very cold weather. Full sun. Adapted to medium or heavy moist soils. Grows 30-60'T x 15-25'W

### Meyer Spruce:

Full sun. Alternative to Colorado Spruce with blue-green color. Imported cultivar that currently has no known diseases— for now. Full sun. Adapted to a wide variety of soils. Grows 30-45'T x 15-25'W

### Norway Spruce:

Faster growing of the spruces. Evergreen foliage. Grows very tall and very long lived. Full sun. Prefers soil with ample moisture. Grows >100'T x 20-35'W

### White Spruce:

Very hardy, dusty green to bluish spruce. Full sun. Adapted to wide variety of soils. Grows up to 40-60' x 15-25'W



## TREE CARE

### Tree Shelters:

6' tall shelter includes zip ties, a 7' stake and bird exclusion net caps. Protects seedlings from wildlife, wind and weeds.



## DECIDUOUS

### Black Cherry:

Large long lived tree. Berries are edible and very beneficial for wildlife. Flowers are also very beneficial for pollinators. Adapted to wide variety of soils. Grows up to 50-75'T x 30-60'W

### Red Splendor Crabapple:

Fast growing. Rosy pink flowers in Spring followed by edible fruit. Disease resistant and berries stay on the tree most of the winter for wildlife. Full sun to part shade. Tolerates wide variety of soils. Grows 20-25'T x 20'W

### Red Maple:

Brilliant yellow, orange & red fall foliage. Full sun. Thrives in a wide variety of soils with ample moisture. Grows 40-60'T x 30-50'W

### Sugar Maple:

Yellow to Orangish Red fall foliage. Sap can be collected to make maple syrup. Full sun or partial shade. Prefers medium to well drained soils. Grows 40-70'T x 30-50'W

### Bur Oak:

Yellow to tannish-brown fall foliage. Nuts are an excellent wildlife food source. Full sun preferred, moderately shade tolerant. Adapted to wide variety of soils. Grows 40-70'T x 35-60'W

### Red Oak:

Excellent orange to red fall foliage. One of the faster growing oaks. Nuts are an excellent wildlife food source. Adapted to wide variety of soils. Grows 50-70'T x 40-80'W

### Swamp White Oak:

Reddish-bronze fall color. Among the hardiest of Oaks. Grows well in wet areas. Nuts are an excellent wildlife food source. Adapted to wide variety of soils. Grows 50-60' T x 40-50' W

### Hybrid Willow:

Fast Growing- Under ideal conditions can grow over 6 feet per year. Plant as narrow as 5 foot spacing for a dense fast growing windbreak. Prefers moist soil but can tolerate dry with watering. Needs full to partial sun. Grows 50-70' T x 20-30'W

### Tree Mats:

40"x40" mat that kills existing weeds and stops new weeds before they start. Lasts 3-5 years.



## SHRUBS

### American Cranberrybush:

Large native shrub with red berries. Pollinator friendly white flowers that bloom in late May. Partial shade to full sun. Prefers medium drained soils. Grows 8-12'T x 8-12'W

### Red Twig Dogwood:

Multi-stemmed native shrub. Brilliant red stems in winter. Purple-red fall foliage. Very important food source for birds and deer. Full sun to partial shade. Adapts to most soils. Grows 7-9'T x 10'W

### Elderberry:

Thicket forming shrub. Edible berries are excellent for wildlife. Pollinator friendly flowers bloom in late June. Full sun or partial shade. Adapts to most soils. Grows 6-12'T x 6-12'W

### American Hazelnut:

Tall shrub with numerous upright stems. Nuts are an excellent wildlife food source. Shade tolerant. Grows best on rich, moist well drained soils but can tolerate heavier soils. Grows 8-15'T x 4'W

### Common Purple Lilac:

Medium to large hardy shrub. Fragrant purple flowers in spring. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Adapts to most soils. Full sun. Grows 8-12'T x 6-12'W

### False Indigo:

Bluish-purple flower is very beneficial to butterflies and other pollinators. Full sun to partial shade. Adapts to most soils, but prefers moisture. Grows 6-20'T x 5-15'W

### American Plum:

Tall shrub to small tree. Edible fruit is excellent for wildlife. Very beneficial to pollinators because it is the first native shrub to bloom. Full sun to partial shade. Adapts to most soils. Grows 8-10'T x 8-10'W

### Serviceberry (Juneberry):

Shrub that grows in a wide variety of soils. Edible fruit are excellent for wildlife. Pollinator friendly white flowers. Full sun to part shade. Adapts to most soils. Grows 6-15'T x 5-12'W
